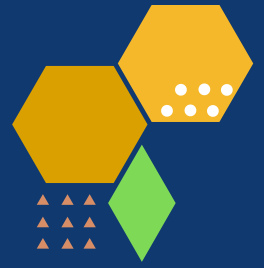

Principal

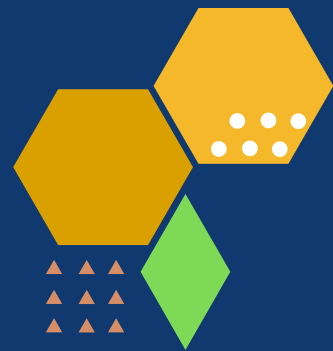

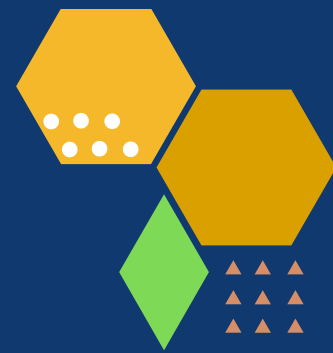
**BING LEE**

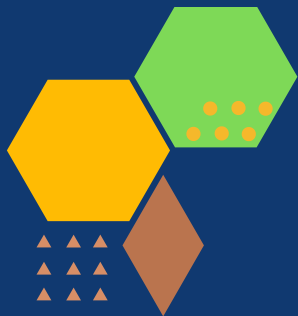


**THAO TRUONG THI PHUONG**
