APU has been providing American quality education here in Vietnam for sixteen years. When I returned to Vietnam many years ago, I saw, in the eyes of many young people that I encountered from all regions of our country, that they were longing for a good, and a quality education.

Since 2004, APU has and will continue our tradition of providing a strong foundation of academic excellence, for our students, which ensures their academic success. A large number of our graduates have gone on to prestigious, and outstanding United States universities, for undergraduate and graduate degrees. Many APU Alumni have graduated near the top of their university classes.

APU International School is currently located in District 11, in HCMC. In 2015, we opened a second school in Da Nang, namely APU American International School. It also shares a campus with The American University in Vietnam, or AUV, which is partnered with a number of outstanding universities in the United States, such as Arizona State University, The University of Missouri, Kansas City, and Virginia Commonwealth University. Students at APU may also take Dual Enrollment Classes, here, and receive academic credits at a university in the United States. These classes are taught by instructors who are approved by the faculty of various academic departments, within these universities.

Our teachers, many of whom have graduate degrees from prestigious universities in the United States, such as Johns Hopkins University, Columbia University, Tulane University, and many other schools of higher learning. APU's teachers are highly qualified. They instill in their students, not only academic knowledge, but creativity, critical thinking, civic, and personal responsibility. Our teachers, many of whom have also earned a teacher's license

through universities in the United States, devote their efforts, each day, to the intellectual, social, and character development of their students.

It is very gratifying to see that almost every year, the majority of APU graduates receiving generous scholarships from top U.S. universities. APU students have a world-wide reputation for their outstanding academic achievements in their universities, abroad. Approximately 85% of APU graduates have earned places on the Dean's List of their respective universities around the world. Dear Students,


